Commitment to achieving Net Zero

Eden Renewable Innovations Ltd is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by 2050. We have set a science-based target to reduce our emissions in line with the ambition criteria of the SBTi.

Baseline Year

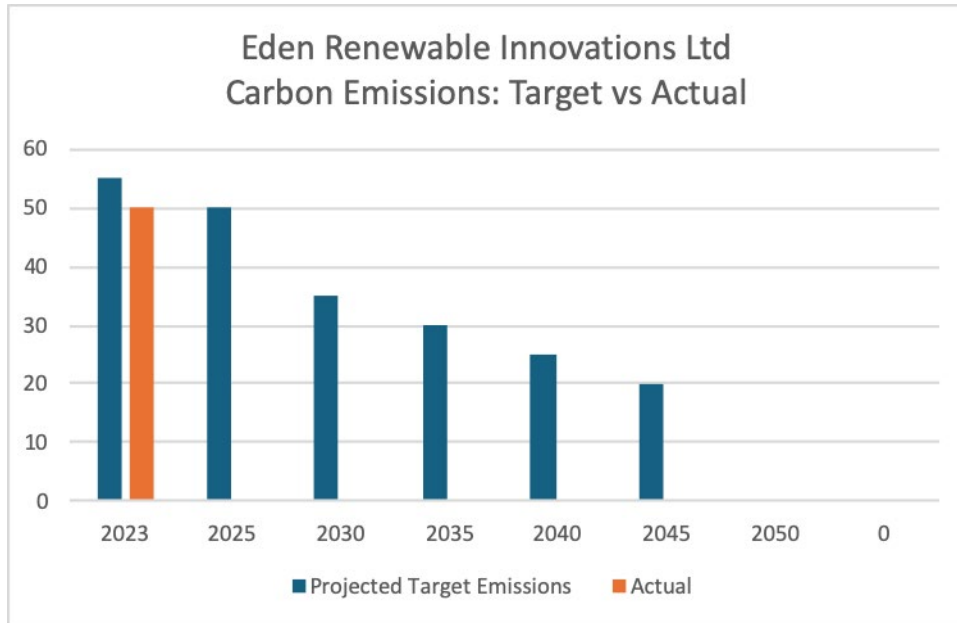
Our emissions across Scopes 1, 2 and 3 have been externally calculated. Our baseline year spans from 01/04/2023 – 31/03/2024 which is the company's financial year.

Our annual Carbon Footprint Recording is aligned with the GHG protocol and as such, tracks material sources of emissions, which for Eden Renewable Innovations Ltd include Scope 3 emissions from waste, business travel, staff commute and downstream logistics.

Emissions reduction targets

Eden Renewable Innovations Ltd reduction target has been set in line with the ambition criteria of the Science Based Targets Initiative (SBTI).

We have set an ambitious target to reduce our Scope 2 emissions in line with the ambition criteria of the SBTI, by at least 30% by 2030. This decrease will see our Scope 2 emissions drop from **3.44 tCO₂e** to **2.41 tCO₂e** by 2030.



Carbon Reduction Projects

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2023 baseline.

ISO14001 Implementation: Implementing ISO14001 Environmental Management Standard to improve environmental performance and ensure sustainable practices.

ISO9001 Implementation: Implementing ISO9001 Quality Management Standard to ensure quality of products and services.

Renewable Energy: Purchase 100% of energy from renewable sources across all company sites.

Renewable Energy: Installing onsite renewable energy sources through solar panels

Staff Training: Undertaking Environmental Awareness Training for all staff

Working with Suppliers: Extending the range of environmentally friendly, low carbon products by working with suppliers.

In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Introduce Energy Efficiency and Carbon Management to staff inductions and refresher toolbox talks for existing members of staff.

- *Commit to a carbon management policy and communicate to staff the aims and ambition of the policy and the role that they can play.*
- *Carry out a strategic waste review*
- *Develop a companywide Travel Policy*
- *Offer staff driver training*
- *Develop a companywide Sustainable Procurement Policy*
- *Signing up to SBTi*
- *Aligning with Sustainable Development Goals*
- *Require key suppliers to report their carbon footprint data to us to improve the accuracy of carbon measurement and engaging with suppliers to support our net zero goal.*
- *Develop partnerships to implement carbon offsetting that comprise traditional carbon credit projects alongside carbon capture process.*
